

Princess Costume

Princess Costume Tip -

Cat looks like a princess in her pink tutu and sparkling heart tiara. For extra sparkle, add glitter to her tiara.



Princess Makeup Tip -

After you color & cut out her makeup, be sure the Princess Cat shares a bit of the blush & powder with her friend.

Use the powder puff to get rid of any wet cat nose.


Use the beautiful, rose blush in a circular motion on her cheeks.

Now, cat looks like a princess!



Princess Makeup

Cut on these solid lines to help the doll stand up.



Fold on dotted lines.

Instructions:

1. Print on card stock.
2. *Student* - colors dolls, costumes & makeup.
3. *Teacher* - Laminare or cover each side with clear packing tape to make it last longer (optional).
4. *Student* - Cuts paper dolls out of laminate or clear packing tape (optional).
5. Read the book and act out the story with the girl and her cat.

Cat Costume

Cat Costume Tip - "Meow!"

When you cut out the costume, be sure to remove the two pieces (head and body).

Then, cut out a hole where the girl's face should be.



Cat Makeup Tip -

Color the heart nose pink. Cut out the circle around the heart nose. Put the colored side on the sticky side of the tape. Put the pink cat nose on the girl paper doll's nose. (This will only work if the doll is laminated.) Get a black pen and make the whiskers on the tape. Simply remove the tape to take off the cat costume nose and whiskers.
